What is the aim of Community grants?

The Commission awards financial assistance in the form of **grants** in order to implement projects or activities **in relation to European Union policies**.

These grants may be awarded within fields as diverse as research, education, health, consumer protection, protection of the environment, humanitarian aid, etc.



What we mean by «Grants»?

Who can request a grant?

The grant **beneficiaries** are mainly private or public organisations, and exceptionally individuals, chosen by the European Commission for their capacity to implement the projects concerned.

- you should know EU Transport Policy and the relevant targets, policy papers and aims of this policy



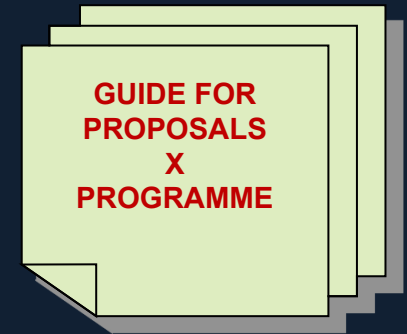
Planning of call for proposals by the EU

- Finds its relevance in some EU regulations, directives, policy papers, Communications, work programmes
- Depends upon the policy framework of the subject. You should carefully study the works of the relevant DG under European Commission
- Departments of the Commission that manage grant programmes publish their annual work programme on their Internet site. The work programme fixes the broad outlines of the grants that are envisaged over the year (area of activity, objectives, timetable, available budget, award conditions, etc.)

Each call for proposal has its own rules of each grant programme.
